

Dr. Mohamed M. Shams

Dr. Mohamed M. Shams is President of the Economic and Managerial Feasibility Consultancy Center (EMFCC), President of Mohamed Mahmud Shams' Trading Establishment and Translation Office, and an economic writer for several journals including the Aleqtisadiah Journal, Okaz.

From 1992 to 2002, Dr. Shams held the position of Senior Planning and Program Analyst in Saudi Aramco. Prior to this, he was a Senior Advisor to the Minister of Industry and Electricity in 1996, Economic Advisor to a British firm from 1997 to 2004, and Associate Professor of Economics in KFUPM from 1977 to 1992. He also served as an Economist in the Ministry of Agriculture and Water and Ministry of Commerce for 10 years.
