

## **Mohannad F. Al-Madhi**

Mohannad F. Al-Madhi is the Advisor to the Saudi Railway Organization (SRO). Second to the World Bank, the SRO is the largest greenfield railway and privatization transaction currently ongoing in the world. The procurement processes of the project were in accordance with World Bank standards. Mr. Al-Madhi's responsibilities include contract design and negotiation, monitoring contract progress, measuring performance, and setting evaluation and selection criteria for the advisors. He monitors contract payment on a milestone basis, according to quality and cost-based principles and interacts with government, international companies and financial institutions represented by senior management. He also set evaluation parameters for the selection of financial, technical and legal advisors. Mr. Al-Madhi assisted with development of RFI, RFPQ, RFP, and the administration and execution of contracted services.

Mr. Al-Madhi is also the Assistant Project Manager for the World Bank in Washington, DC. Since 2000, he has been responsible for reviewing the scope of work of complex projects and their schedules. He participated in the review of A/E construction documentation and proposed engineering management schemes. Mr. Al-Madhi has also worked for ADC Construction in Washington, DC and Khateeb Engineering Consultants in Jeddah, KSA.
