

Dr. Zohair A. Nawab

Zohair Nawab has served as the Senior Advisor to the Office of the Ministry of Petroleum and Mineral Resources since 2003. He is a Board Member of the Saudi Geological Survey, Saudi Arabian Mining Company (MAADEN), and the Steering Committee for Railway Expansion Projects.

Dr. Nawab was a field geologist until he retired as Deputy Minister for Mineral Resources in April 2003. He was a member of the Saudi Company for Precious Metals from 1989 to 1998; Assistant Secretary General for the Saudi-Sudanese Red Sea Commission from 1978 to 1985; and a member of the Saudi Arabian Delegation to the U.N. Law of the Sea Conference and the U.N. Sea-bed Authority for many years.

Dr. Nawab earned his Ph.D. in Geology from UWO at London, Ontario, Canada and a degree in Applied Geology from SDS for Technology, Rapid City, South Dakota. He has co-authored three books and has been published in many other papers.
